We do require ALL application information to be honestly filled out.

We will be taking limited deposits. After those are filled, we will put you on a waiting list.

Prior education requirements:

- High-content wolfdogs are NOT beginner animals, and prior or similar experience is required.
- High contents take a LOT more work, time and socialization than low or mid contents.
- High-content wolfdogs require a raw, bone-in diet for optimal health. This diet can be very expensive, but it is a must.
- High-content wolfdogs require 8-10ft fencing with lean-in tops, dig guards to prevent digging out, and optional hotwire fencing. They CAN NOT free-roam or be left unsupervised in an unenclosed area
- Continual training is a must. Even no-contact facilities will need to properly maintain the animal's training to make sure it remains comfortable with human interaction.
- Knowledge on canine training and behavior is a must. Please make sure you have done your research on Winter Wolf syndrome, canine sibling rivalry, canine hormonal changes, food aggression, resource possession / resourceaggression, and dominance behavior.

If you and your facility are prepared to move forward, please note:

- You are required to know the laws regarding wolfdogs for your state AND county. We will be checking the legality of your area, as well as any applicable licenses or permits upon application.
- Residents of illegal states or counties, and facilities without proper permits will NOT be considered for a NGWP wolfdog pup
- You will be required to provide proof of proper containment. This includes photos, videos, video calls etc. where you show us where the animals will be housed.
- NGWP Wolfdog puppies will come with an Embark DNA test and health screening results

- You will be required to sign a contract. The contract will include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - You are not permitted to re-sell, re-home, gift, transfer to another owner or another facility, or surrender NGWP pups to sanctuaries, or otherwise impart any part or the whole ownership of the pup at any time. If you find yourself unable to keep the animal for whatever reason, you WILL be required to return it to NGWP.
 - You are not permitted to purchase a NGWP pup on behalf of another person or any third-party agent not named in the contract, regardless of the relation to you.
- You will be required to sign a Spay and Neuter contract. The contract will include, but is not limited to the following:
 - Puppies are required to be spayed or neutered between the ages of 18-30 months.
 - You will be required to provide proof of sterilization.
 - NGWP puppies are not permitted to be used for breeding under any circumstances at any point in its life, whether intentional or accidental, without the explicit written permission of NGWP
 - Monetary fines will be implemented and strictly enforced upon breaching of the contract
 - NGWP reserves the right to repossess any pup upon failure to sterilize by age 36 months, or if the pup has been involved in an unauthorized breeding, whether intentional or accidental.
